## **San Diego International Airport to offer H1N1 and other vaccinations to ticketed passengers**

*Vaccines available post-security*

SAN DIEGO – January 14, 2010 – The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority has partnered with Pacifica Medical to offer H1N1, pneumonia and other CDC-recommended shots to ticketed passengers and employees at San Diego International Airport.

The flu shots will be offered at four post-security locations in Terminals 1 and 2, from the hours of 6:00am – 6:00pm. The vaccinations are available starting Friday, January 15, and are expected to be available through early 2010.

At each kiosk, travelers will have the option of receiving the H1N1 vaccine as well as a host of other travel-related vaccines, including Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, pneumonia and typhoid. Seasonal flu shots will also be available. For all vaccines, there will be a discount for San Diego residents.

The vaccines are yet another customer service initiative provided by the Airport Authority for the convenience and well-being of its passengers.

*The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority was established by state law in 2003 to operate San Diego International Airport and to address the region's long-term air transportation needs. San Diego International Airport — funded through user fees — generates some \$10 billion in annual economic impact for the region.*
