Due to weather conditions, Southwest Airlines temporarily suspends operations at SDIA, possibly through 4 p.m. today

SAN DIEGO – January 21, 2010 – Due to high wind conditions, Southwest Airlines has temporarily suspended its operations at San Diego International Airport (SAN). The airline plans to resume operations, possibly after 4 p.m. today, although that may change depending on weather conditions.

Southwest Airlines is reporting similar suspensions at Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport. Other airports in the southwest may be similarly affected, depending on weather conditions.

Southwest Airlines accounts for about a third of all flights at SAN. Currently, all other air carriers are operating normally at SAN. Airport staff is working with Southwest Airlines to assist the passengers that are in the terminal.

Before heading to the airport, please check flight status information.
