Airport Authority announces The Green Build “Big Opportunities for Small Contractors” event to help small local firms get construction jobs

SAN DIEGO – June 1, 2010 – The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority is offering the last in a series of events titled “Big Opportunities for Small Contractors,” designed to help small local construction contractors get actively involved with The Green Build, a major upgrade project to San Diego International Airport’s Terminal 2.

Airport Authority officials [are](#) strongly encouraging small companies, including Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, to bid on portions of the \$1 billion project. Because smaller firms may have little experience bidding on government contracts, the event aims to provide hands-on training in registering, pre-qualifying and bidding on airport work. Help will be available for every stage of the bid process, including completing paperwork and fulfilling certification requirements. Contractors from all trades are encouraged to attend.

The event will be held on Thursday, June 3, from 3:30 – 5:30 p.m. at Santee Civic Center, 10601 Magnolia Avenue, Santee, CA 92071. Additional events will be scheduled over the next year as The Green Build continues to progress and additional contracting opportunities become available.
